Jaycee is well, but Josh is not well.

She's very thirsty, so she drinks one bottle of water.

We're hungry and thirsty, so let's eat and drink.

Contractions, Emotions, and Negatives

Your banana is on the table.

Now I'm not hungry, but I'm thirsty.

You're thirsty, and I'm thirsty.

Let's drink a glass of cold water.

One month ago Jen was not well.

She ate oranges and drank cold water.

Now she's well, and she's not hungry or thirsty.

Bryce is thirsty but not hungry.

He's thirsty, but he's not hungry.

Bryce drinks water and eats food.

Now he's not thirsty or hungry.

There are two men.

They're teachers.

Their students are happy.
