Drink

I'm not hungry, so I don't eat the sandwich. I'm thirsty, but the orange juice is bad. I don't drink the bad orange juice.

Dan, here is a cup of apple juice. Thank you, Debby. I drink the apple juice. And Dan, here is a bottle of water. I was very thirsty, but now I'm not thirsty. I do not drink the water.
